Sound Technicians

The Sound Technician will run the audio and timing of the show onboard each train and will coordinate with the museum's onboard service manager as well as sound and light technicians who run the show off the train. Must have experience with QLab software and trained in running cues. Must be organized, adaptable, flexible, a team player, and a leader. The Sound Technician acts as a liaison between the performers, onboard service manager, and scheduling personnel. Must be able to react quickly and effectively to show staffing needs and changes that develop. Other related duties as needed.
