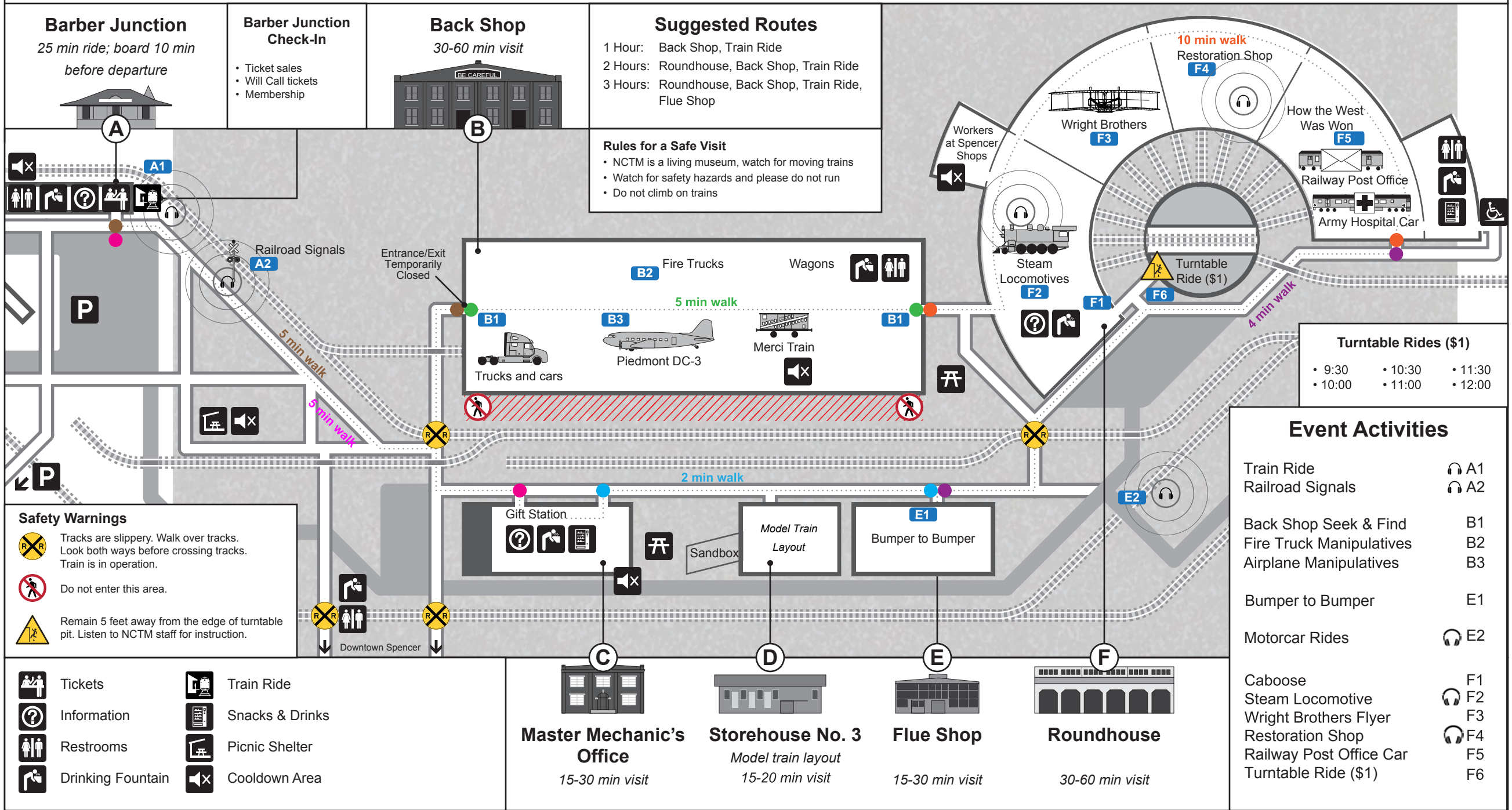


Suggested Routes
