

## **Train Ride**



While visiting the transportation museum, you have the opportunity to ride on a train. The train ride will last **25-minutes**. Before you ride the train, you will have to go to the **Barber Junction** to get your ticket so you can board the train.



After you get your ticket, you may have to **wait in line to board the train**. There may be other people in front and behind you. It is okay to wait. Remember, if you have a ticket, you will get a turn to ride on the train.



Once you board the train, **find your seat with your family.** You can sit with your body in the chair or stand in front of your chair. **Keep your hands, feet and body in your area.** There will be someone coming by to collect your ticket. It is okay to hand him or her your ticket or ask your family for help.



Once the train starts, there may be some rocking. There may be some loud noises or weird smells. It is okay. It is part of the train riding experience. The train will ride out to one point and then return. When the train ride ends, you can say “thank you” to the conductor and other individuals on the train. You will have to wait in line to get off the train. When you leave the train, check your schedule or ask your family, “What’s Next?”
