KIA's (Know-It-All's) appear in a uniform vest and conductor-style hat, punching tickets and interacting with passengers. This is an interactive performance requiring teamwork and excellent customer service skills to help create the magic of THE POLAR EXPRESS™ Train Ride. Performers also do light train car cleanup during and after each performance.

This is a paid hourly position. Pay rates will be discussed at time of interview/audition.

There are multiple performances per day. Call time is 60 minutes before first show. Ending time is approximately 90 minutes after the last train departure. A full schedule will be available at the time of interview/audition.

Must be age 15 and up to apply.

THE POLAR EXPRESS™ Train Ride is a 70-minute live theatrical production that happens several times per night on a moving train at the N.C. Transportation Museum. In addition to acting talent, we are looking for crew members who are team players, who like working with kids, and who embrace the interaction between themselves and passengers.
