What is the Passport Program?

The ASTC Travel Passport Program is a reciprocal admission program that offers a travel benefit to the members of Passport Program participating science centers or museums.



Reciprocal Admissions

NCTM members receive the following admissions at other participating science centers or museums:

- **Individual & Sr. Individual** memberships receive **one free admission**.
- **Lifetime, Family Platinum, Family Premium, and Family** memberships receive up to **2 adults and 4 children**.
- **Companion** memberships are at the discretion of the institution you plan to visit.



Traveling Tips

- Contact the institution you plan on visiting to confirm benefits received.
- Take your membership card or proof of membership.
- Reciprocal admissions may not be provided when traveling within 90 miles of the N.C. Transportation Museum.
- Centers within 90 linear miles from the N.C. Transportation Museum that have separate reciprocity agreements with us are:
Catawba Science Center - Hickory, NC / Kaleideum, Winston-Salen, NC
Schiele Museum of Natural History & Planetarium, Gastonia, NC
- ASTC Passport Program Exclusions - N.C. Transportation Museum members do not receive reciprocal benefits from:
Discovery Place - Charlotte, NC / Discovery Place Kids - Huntersville, NC
